Ms. Johanna Järvinen joined the Safety Investigation Authority, Finland (SIAF) as the Administrative Director in March 2025. She is a lawyer with two decades of frontline and high-level experience on personal data protection and data security issues. She has also built strong expertise in matters regarding good governance and the sensitive balance of openness and confidentiality of government activities. Within the Finnish Safety Investigation Authority, she is responsible for the administration as well as operational and financial planning in cooperation with the Executive Director, Mr. Kokko. Johanna supports the safety investigation, is the leader of the administration team and the Deputy Director of the bureau.

Prior to the SIAF, Johanna held the position of Chief Specialist for operational data protection within the Finnish Ministry of Justice. She also functioned as the Chair for the Personal Data Protection Network of the Finnish Government. Previously she has worked as an Administrative Bailiff for the National Administrative Office for Enforcement, and as a Senior Inspector for the Finnish Data Protection Authority.

Johanna strongly values international cooperation, as well as the exchange of information and best practices. She has led an EU TALEX project in North Macedonia, an EU Schengen evaluation project in Malta and participated in an EU Twinning project in Kyrgyzstan.

Johanna holds a Master of Laws degree from the University of Helsinki.
